Where are the Sewing Lounge sessions?

Sessions take place at the North Michigan Recreation Center at 13th Street NE and Emerson Street NE, Washington, DC 20017. There is plenty of parking available at the Center, and it is a 15-20 minute walk from the Fort Totten metro station on the red and green lines.

What does it cost?
