

## **The Quick & Easy Pillowcase Pattern**

This pillowcase can be made in under an hour and is tons of fun!! This pattern is customized for a standard pillow, measuring 20" x 30". Make sure to make any necessary adjustments for larger pillows.

### **Materials Needed:**

- 3/4 yard Main Fabric
- 1/8 yard Narrow Trim Fabric
- 1/3 yard Cuff Fabric

### **Cutting Instructions:**

1. From Main Fabric, cut one (1) – 24" x 40½" piece
2. From Narrow Trim Fabric, cut one (1) – 1½" x 40½" piece
3. From Cuff Fabric, cut one (1) – 12" x 40½" piece

### **Pillowcase Construction:**

1. Fold narrow trim in half lengthwise, wrong sides together. Press. On the right side of your main fabric, base raw edge of narrow trim to one (1) 40½" edge using a ¼" seam.
2. Right sides together, place cuff fabric on top of prepared main fabric, matching the raw edges. Stitch using a ½" seam. Press seam allowance toward cuff fabric.
3. Fold pillowcase in half lengthwise, right sides together. Stitch side and end opposite cuff using a ½" seam. To finish the seam neatly, you may choose to serge or zigzag the edge. Turn right side out.
4. On open end, press ½" to wrong side. To form the cuff, bring the pressed edge to cover the stitching line on the inside. Pin. On outside of cuff, topstitch close to narrow trim, making sure to catch the cuff fabric on the inside. Press.
